

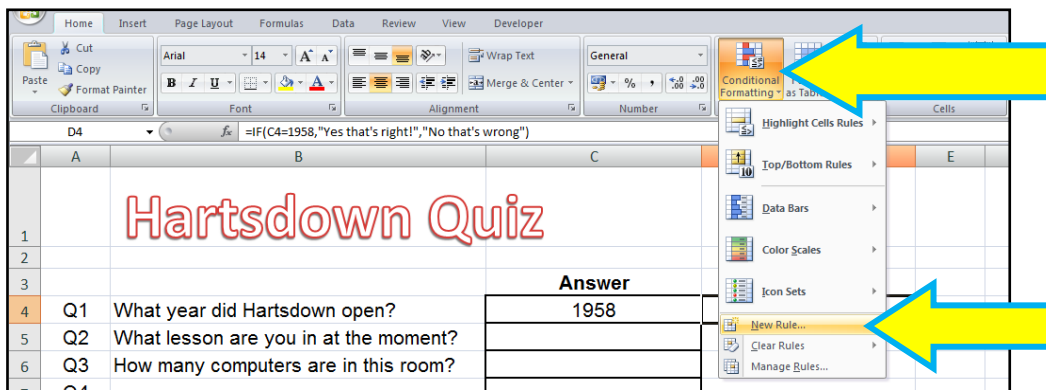


Conditional Formatting

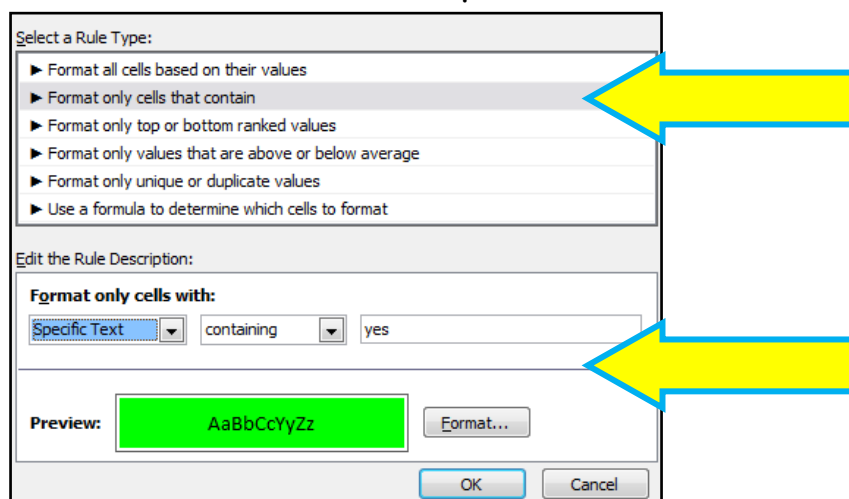
Conditional formatting allows different things to happen in different conditions.

Here we are going to make the cell change colour to **green** if they have answered correctly or **red** if they got it wrong.

1. Select the cells to be conditionally formatted then from the **Home Tab** select **Conditional Formatting** then **New Rule**:



2. From the dialogue box change Rule Type to "format only cells that contain" then edit the rule description as shown here:



This is for a "Correct Answer", repeat the process again to format wrong answers.
