


KODU in the KLASSROOM & TeachMeet

About this Seminar

Kodu is a new, free, programming environment from Microsoft which is colourful and engaging for learners of all ages. This seminar gives an introduction to how this can be used to meet the needs of the secondary ICT curriculum.

The seminar will give delegates a chance to learn the basic skills of using Kodu to create a simple game and will then move onto game design and problem solving in the afternoon. A Scheme of Work for teaching Kodu to Key Stage 3 will also be supplied for delegates to use in their own schools.

The seminar is free (funded by Microsoft) and lunch will be provided along with refreshments throughout the day.

The day will close with a TeachMeet, giving willing delegates an opportunity to share best practice within their ICT classrooms in the form of short presentations of either 2 or 7 minutes.
